REQUIREMENTS FOR PAPERS

The text of a paper has to be printed in Word for Windows (version 6.0 and higher) with *.doc extension. It has to be prepared in Times New Roman Cyr, 12 pt, single spaced, justified. The margins are: top, bottom, left, right – 20 mm. The page orientation must be portrait, A4 size, without hyphenation. A new line of paragraph has to be intended by 1.25 cm from the left margin. A paper has to be 4-6 entirely filled pages.

In the upper left corner there must be UDC, through one blank line there must be the title of the report in in capitalized letters, bold, centered, without hyphenation. Through one blank line there must be author's name and initials, centered, the next line is name of organization in italics. Then, through one blank line all the submitted text is printed.

Only Arabic numbers and captions with an initial capital have to be used for table enumeration (e.g., Table 1, Table 2, etc.). Also, has to be left one blank line before and after each table or figure. For the layout of figures' title have to be applied the same rules as for tables. Figures must be black-and-white, without color filling and should be placed in the body of an article in *.jpg format.

References have to be sorted in alphabetical order. All cited publications in the text have to be presented in square brackets [2] and shown in the references. Examples of referencing of various sources of information are presented in Russian National Standard (GOST) 7.1-2003. The references have to be translated into English. In case there are not any references, there shouldn't be references in form of numbers inside the square brackets.

Equations and formulas have to be typed in MathType.

The permissible level of citation must be 70% of author's unique text.

Participants send in copies of the text either on electronic device or by e-mail.

Materials not meeting these requirements will not be accepted and published.

The organizing committee reserves the right of selecting of materials for publication.

INFORMATION (Russian and English language) ATTACHED TO THE REPORT (PAPER)

1. UDC.
2. The title of the report (paper) (in capitalized letters, bold).
3. Information about authors (in Russian and English languages). In case a paper was prepared by two or more authors, data about each of them have to be presented separately.
 - Surname, name, patronymic (full name, without shortenings and initials).
 - Institutional affiliation (full name without shortenings).
 - Address of institutional affiliation (including post code). In case all the authors work or study at the same educational establishment you needn't to write institutional affiliation for each author.
 - Scientific degree, academic title, occupied position.
 - Contact telephone.
 - E-mail.
 - Information about authors is given in the order of their mentioning.
4. Abstract (short summary of the paper, it should be limited to 3-4 sentences).
5. Key-words (each key-word or key-word combination is separated with comma).
6. References.
